

## Harewood Junior School SDP Curriculum action plan for P.E 2025/26

## **PRIORITY:**

- Continue to develop teacher's competence and confidence for teaching P.E, in a range of disciplines.
- Continue to increase opportunities for physical activity, particularly those identified as a concern.
- Continue to embed children's understanding of the importance of leading a healthy, active lifestyle including an understanding of the impact of physical activity on mental health and wellbeing.
- Continue to invest in equipment and resources to ensure that a range of physical education disciplines can be taught effectively.
- Increase the percentage of our children who meet the end of KS2 national swimming expectations.

## **SUCCESS CRITERIA:**

- Gaps in staff confidence and competence addressed through CPD.
- Increased opportunities for daily physical activity.
- Continue to develop the school ethos around the importance of living a healthy, active lifestyle, with particular attention to the impact of physical activity of our physical and mental health and wellbeing: healthy active days; assemblies; whole school events; visitors.
- Children act on the knowledge that a healthy, active lifestyle impacts our physical and mental health and wellbeing.
- PE equipment matches the delivery of high-quality lessons.
- Explore and invest in opportunities for 'top-up' swimming lessons so that a greater percentage of our pupils meet the end of KS2 swimming criteria.
