

Curriculum summary for Summer Term: Year 5 2023-2024

LITERACY: In addition to teaching spelling patterns and literacy skills, we will also be teaching a range of genres this term.

Balanced argument- rewinding

Diary / Historical fiction- Daily Life of a Viking

Narrative Poetry – The Highwayman

Assessments: In addition to formal assessments during assessment week, children will complete a piece of Big Writing each term. We will use this to monitor progress.

Spellings:

Children will investigate a different spelling pattern each week as well as revisit previous patterns and high frequency words which are commonly misspelled. These patterns will be assessed weekly through dictation of sentences to ensure understanding of meaning.
