

Year 4 – Statutory Multiplication Test

The multiplication tables check is statutory for all year 4 pupils in England.

The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided.

Children should be able to answer the multiplication questions in under 6 seconds. This includes the time it takes to type in the answer to the iPad. The format of the test is identical to the Times Table Rockstars platform, and regular use will both support your child in developing their multiplication knowledge, speed of recall and accuracy of answer input.

Multiplication checks this year will take place in June.
